Formerly known as Jazz on South Beach Hostel and most recently Lifehouse South of Fifth, the property currently holds 196 beds with potential capacity to increase to 218 beds. Feasibility study done for 3rd floor addition & new owner can activate lobby with liquor license/ food and beverage. Steps to the best restaurants, nightlife, and retail.

This prime hospitality asset is located in one of Miami Beach's most coveted and exclusive zones-South of Fifth-where high barriers to entry make it a true investor's dream. Surrounded by ultra-luxury residential towers like Apogee, Glass, One Ocean, Beach House, and Continuum-where prices range from \$1,500 - \$5,000 per square foot-this property sits at the center of prestige and opportunity.

THE NEIGHBORHOOD/AREA

Located in the neighborhood dubbed South of Fifth, 321 Collins Avenue has the feel of a private beach villa—subtle and low-key by design. Tucked inside a 1930s-era manor, the 26-room hotel seamlessly blends into the quiet charm of SoFi's low-rise neighborhood. Here, you're more likely to spot locals on a leisurely walk or beachgoers heading to the shore than throngs of tourists. It's a serene contrast to the towering hotels and buzzing nightlife of Ocean Drive just to the north. The property's entrance serves as an inviting outdoor living room, where guests and neighbors alike can enjoy the local backdrop. Tucked behind the property is a charming courtyard bar known as 'the laneway,' lined with cozy café-style two-top tables. These outdoor spaces were thoughtfully designed with locals in mind, especially the laneway, which was envisioned as a go-to date spot for SoFi residents.

THE VIBE

Upon entering the hotel, guests are welcomed into a cozy, living room-style lobby that feels more like a thoughtfully curated home than a traditional hotel. A charming seating nook, communal dining table, and a cement bar with wood paneling and stained glass details create a warm, inviting atmosphere-equal parts artist's retreat and beachgoers' escape.

There's no conventional front desk here. The hotel offers a fully touchless check-in experience, allowing guests to skip the front desk entirely. Using intuitive self-service tablets or their own mobile devices, travelers can check in, receive room details, and even generate key cards-all without contact. The streamlined process enhances the feeling that you're staying in a stylish guesthouse or a friend's beachside home, rather than a standard hotel.

THE ROOMS

On the first floor, you will find traditional private hotel rooms, whereas Upstairs, there's a variety of room layouts for all types of travelers. Two of the rooms feature custom-made full-size quadruple bunk beds for group travel. Rooms are also stocked with bathing products and small vintage fridges.

FOOD & BEVERAGE: 2ND GENERATION KITCHEN SPACE

The former outpost of Pretty Swell, the shortly lived restaurant & bar from Lifehouse Hotels, is located in the indoor lobby area with a bar, banquettes, and a communal table, in addition to two outdoor areas. One, a garden patio, that could serve as a cafe with the ability to transition the space into a tropical lounge when the sun goes down. The second outdoor space is a more private courtyard with a bistro vibe, where a main seating area can be formed to service the full restaurant.




